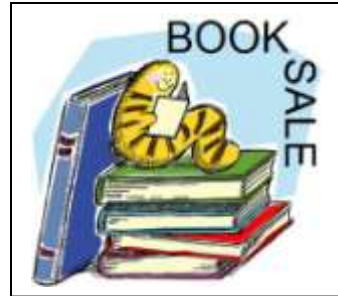

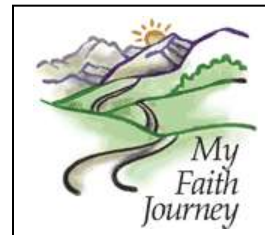
PLEASE NOTE:
