Finance Committee Budget Update

Every week the bulletin will report the collection for the preceding week. It will also report the amount of the deficit or surplus for the year to date.

The deficit or surplus will be determined by comparing the income from collections thus far this year to the income budgeted for the entire fiscal year from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. For example, if the annual income from collections were budgeted at \$520,000, the average weekly collection would have to be \$10,000 per week to avoid a deficit. 31 weeks have passed since July 1st, therefore we would have to have collected at least \$303,800 or there would be a deficit. We know that collections are never even, and in fact, Christmas and Easter collections usually ameliorate deficits. However, Easter is late in the Fiscal Year and if we have a large deficit after the Easter Collections, ending the year in the black is difficult.

Our present budgeted income for the weekend collection is \$509,000. On average we need to collect \$9,800 per week. If we were on budget we would have collected \$303,800 over the last 31 weeks. In fact, we have collected \$305,864. Therefore, our present surplus is \$2,064.

To put this in perspective, at this point in 2010 we had collected \$6,800 more than we have in 2011. In 2009, we had collected \$17,000 more than in 2011. In addition, we budgeted more income in those years than in 2011. We will need every additional dollar of income especially considering this winter weather.

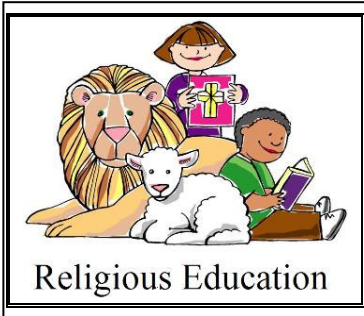
From Sr. Catherine:

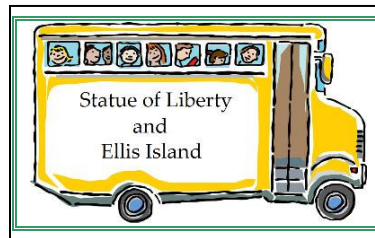
