After the craziness of the holidays, could you give each other any better gift!

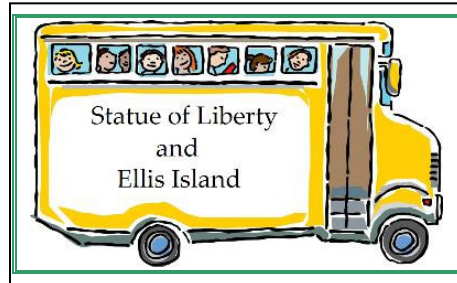

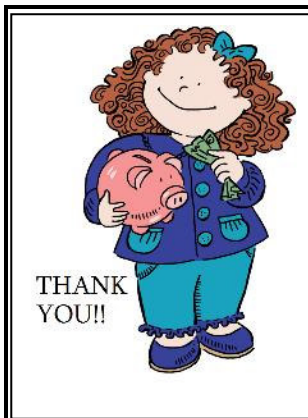
Holy Name Food Pantry: We are in need of cereals,
