Ministry of the Tribunal

All too often in life, we find ourselves carrying a cross. Sometimes they're not too heavy, but sometimes they are very heavy – even crushing. The ministries of the Church are there to help us with our daily crosses. One of these ministries is the Tribunal.

Every Diocese of the Catholic Church maintains a Tribunal (court) to handle questions arising under Church law. In this country, Civil courts decide whether to grant divorces, based on specific grounds defined by civil law. Church Tribunals decide whether the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony took place in individual cases, based on the grounds defined by Church law.

Rulings made by the Tribunal of the Church have no effect on matters properly before the civil courts, such as child support and legitimacy of children.

Diocesan Tribunals provide a healing ministry in many instances where, for specific reasons, a marriage did not rise to the level of being a sacrament, regardless of the good intentions of the parties. In these instances, the Tribunal can enable individuals of good conscience to again plan marriage in the Church after due consideration and adequate preparation.

You can learn more about the Tribunal and its ministry to divorced persons in subsequent civil marriages that are not recognized by the Church.
