As you may be aware, the air conditioning in the Church needs to be repaired. Grodsky has

been servicing the system for many years – we called them in again to look at the unit. In order to effectively cool the Church, a new barrel for the system is needed. The barrel has been repaired many times and now must be replaced. We have ordered a new barrel and it should be installed soon. All this being said, this is a costly project.

The price of a new barrel is approximately \$24,000. We have already begun saving and have put aside about \$12,000 to pay for this one time cost. That leaves about half still to be raised.

We are asking for your financial help to repair the system. We will be taking up a second collection next weekend, June 19th and 20th. Any help that you can give to us would be greatly appreciated.

We are happy to report that the air conditioning has been replaced in the Social Center. The cost of that project was \$10,000 and has been paid in full.
