Confessions will be heard on Tuesday evenings during Lent from 5:00 – 5:30, followed by the Saint Jude Novena Mass.

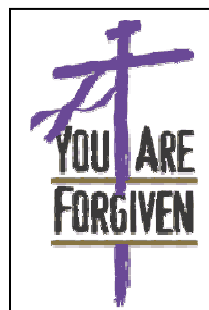
