Simple Chili

This will serve 4 people. For the Soup Kitchen please triple it so it will serve 10 to 12.

$\frac{3}{4}$ lbs hamburger
1 cup chopped onions (smaller amount optional)
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup green peppers chopped
2 cloves of fresh garlic minced (smaller amount optional)
1 (16 ounce) can of red kidney beans (drained)
18 ounce can of tomato sauce
2 teaspoons of chili powder
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of dried basil
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon of salt and pepper

Cook hamburger, onions, garlic and green peppers together until meat is cooked ... drain fat. Add the rest of the ingredients, kidney beans, chili powder, dried basil, salt and pepper. Simmer for 20 minutes.

Thanksgiving Baskets: Every year Holy Name Parish collects a variety of food to provide Thanksgiving meal baskets for those in need. To accomplish this we ask those in our parish to bring canned food items or other types of food as noted below and leave it in the sacristy or by the exit doors,. You can do this anytime up until Monday, November 23rd. The following is a suggested list for donations by last name (doing it this way enables a more even distribution of food collection):

- A-B** Rice, Gravy (mix or canned)
- C-D** Coffee, Tea, Hot Chocolate, Dry Milk
- E-F** Peanut Butter, Jelly, Vegetables
- G-H** Stuffing, Cranberry Sauce
- I-J** Cookies, Cake or Brownie Mix
- K-L** Potatoes, fresh or dried
- M-Mc** Baked Beans, Rice, Cranberry Sauce
- N-O** Canned Vegetables
- P-Q** Canned Fruit, Stuffing
- R-S** Potatoes, fresh or dried, Stuffing
- T-U** Gravy (mixed or canned)
- V-W** Nuts, Raisins, Dried Fruit, Cannied Vegetables
- X-Z** Canned Pumpkin, Evaporated Milk
