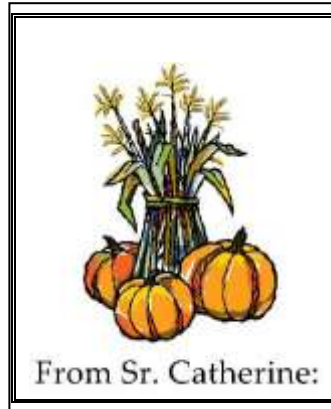

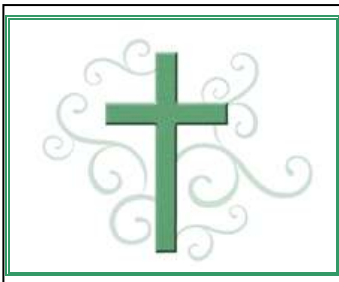


## Religious Education Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>:

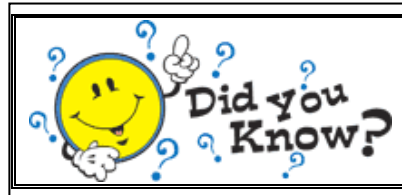
