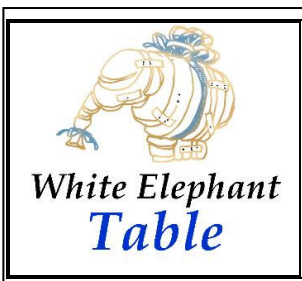
The Holy Name Craft Fair will take place on Saturday, November 20th from 10:00 -

Simple Chili

This will serve 4 people. For the Soup Kitchen, please triple the recipe so it will feed 10 to 12.

- ¾ lbs of hamburger
- 1 cup chopped onions
(smaller amount optional)
- ½ cup chopped green peppers
- 2 cloves of fresh garlic minced
(smaller amount optional)
- 1 (16 ounce) can of red kidney beans
(drained)
- 18 ounce can of tomato sauce
- 2 teaspoons of chili powder
- ½ teaspoon of dried basil
- ¼ teaspoon of salt and pepper

Cook hamburger, onions, garlic and green peppers together until meat is cooked – drain fat. Add the rest of the ingredients, kidney beans, tomato sauce, chili powder, dried basil, salt and pepper. Simmer for 20 minutes.
