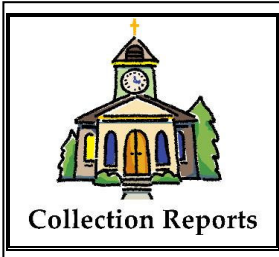

Elderly or Homebound: Do you know of an elderly homebound parishioner that should be on our call list for visitation? Call Sr. Catherine at 781-1785 and we will start

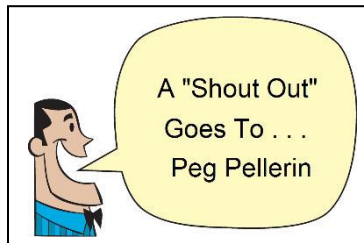
calling on them.

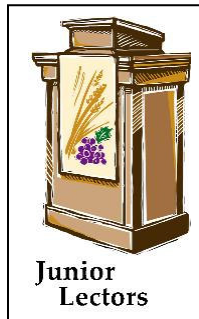

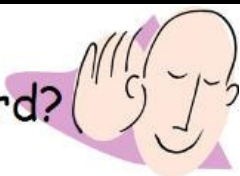
